

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE

All players, coaches and managers are required to register online with Football Australia through the My Football Club (MFC) website via www.myfootballclub.com.au. This is a mandatory process which each club is required to do. Registrations are open from the 1st week in January, you can register online. Below is the way to go about it.

Re-Registering from last season

In order to re-register, you will have to have your FFA No & Password from the MyFootball Club website. You can access the link through our website www.newburybulls.org.au & follow the link. Type your name & your FFA No & this will pop up. If you know your password, type it in, if you have forgotten it enter your email address & follow the prompts. This step is necessary to verify that it is the player re-registering and not someone else. Everyone needs a current email address to register online. Once this is done, you can go into Registrations and register. Follow the prompts, pay online, upload your photo and this will be sent through to us to accept. Please upload a head & shoulders shot, if the photo is not appropriate, you will be notified by us to do it again, so please do this right the first time.

Once the club accepts your registration, you will receive an email stating this. Then you are registered. Also on our website are the dates of Information & Grading days. Grading is from U9s upwards even though FFA has stated that there will be non-competition up to U12s. Competition teams start from U12s. Please make note of the corresponding age groups with their dates and come to these for team allocation and selection processes. Dates on website.

U5-U8 - If you wish to play with the same team or another player, please nominate this in the section provided. Otherwise send us an email. Once the teams are formed, we will hold trial matches for each age group prior to the start of the season. Please keep an eye on our Facebook page for more details.

Adult Teams - If you have a team which you would like to nominate as a whole, we will require a list of names for that team before they start registering. Please send me a list via email so we can cross names off once registered. Please note that for AA teams the maximum number of players in a team is 16 & for O35s the maximum numbers of players is 18. This is mandatory. **Divisions are still allocated by BDSFA and once they have been allocated, no changes will be made. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN UNLESS DUE TO A SERIOUS INJURY. THE CLUB'S DECISION IS FINAL.**

New Registrations - the process is the same as above, except that you won't have a FFA No. Go into New Registrations and follow the prompts. Once you register, an FFA No is allocated to you which will be your number for the rest of your soccer life. Once you register online, you still need to bring your Birth Certificate or Passport to our Registration Days to show proof of ID.
